**ORDER AMENDING CERTAIN SETTLEMENT-RELATED DEADLINES**

On April 19, 2017, the Court entered its Order Granting Plaintiffs’ Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement (the “Order”). The Order establishes various deadlines for settlement notice, class member submissions and claims administration, including several events keyed off the date of the Order. The parties have since advised the Court that, due to delays in obtaining name and address information for distribution of direct notice to potential Settlement Class members, and due to the volume of the information obtained, the settlement administrator, Dahl Administration (“Dahl”), needs additional time in which to commence the class notice program ordered by the Court.

The Court finds good cause for adjusting certain settlement-related deadlines, outlined below. The Court also finds that even with the adjustments, class members will have ample time to receive, review and respond to the settlement notice and to take appropriate action to preserve their rights ahead of the Final Approval Hearing scheduled for August 3, 2017. The Court therefore finds that the Order should be amended, as follows:


- The Notice Date is amended to **May 12, 2017** – by this date, Dahl Administration shall cause the notice campaign to begin as described in the Order.

- The opt-out deadline is **July 11, 2017**, which is sixty days after the Notice Date.
- The deadline for objecting to the settlement is **July 11, 2017**, which is sixty days after the Notice Date. Any objector who intends to appear at the final approval hearing must file a notice of intent to appear as provided in the Order on or before **July 11, 2017**. If an objector retains an attorney to represent him or her for purposes of making an objection, the attorney must formally enter his or her appearance in this case on or before **July 18, 2017**.
- The deadline for submitting a Claim Form is **September 9, 2017**, which is 120 days after the Notice Date.

The notice materials and settlement website shall reflect these amended deadlines. The Order otherwise remains unchanged. The final approval hearing remains scheduled for **August 3, 2017** at 1:30 p.m. in Division 16 of the Jackson County Circuit Court.
